



Accommodation Rules of Chalet Galla

(Pursuant to Section 754 of the Civil Code)

All guests staying at Chalet Galla are required to comply with these accommodation rules. Every guest is obliged to familiarize themselves with the rules.

1. The host is obliged to hand over the accommodation premises in a condition suitable for proper use and ensure the guest's uninterrupted enjoyment of their accommodation rights.
2. The guest has the right to use the designated accommodation premises and their equipment for the agreed duration of their stay. Only the registered number of persons may stay in Chalet Galla. The presence of unregistered guests is prohibited.
3. Check-in is from 2:00 PM on the day of arrival, and check-out is by 10:00 AM on the day of departure. Early check-in and late check-out are possible only upon prior telephone agreement.
4. Guests are provided with keys to the chalet, ski/bike storage, and the technical room. The loss of a chalet key is subject to a fee of 500 CZK.
5. Guests are responsible for the chalet's equipment and inventory. In case of damage to the owner's property, the guest is obliged to report the damage immediately and cover the associated costs.
6. The chalet is heated by a wood-burning stove and electric underfloor heating.
7. Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the chalet. Small pets are allowed only upon prior telephone agreement. Open flames are not allowed in any indoor areas. In case of fire, use the fire extinguisher, which is located next to the fridge and in the ski/bike storage.
8. Final cleaning is included in the price. However, we kindly ask you to perform basic tidying up at the end of your stay (washing the dishes, sorting waste, etc.). Cleaning the used grill is subject to a fee of 300 CZK.
9. Shoes must be removed inside the chalet.
10. By paying for their stay, the guest(s) declare that they have read and agree to comply fully with these operational and accommodation rules.
